### MEDICAL CENTER EXPANSION

The Ohio State University - Columbus, OH

Architect: *KDG for the Cancer & Critical Care Tower*

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 1,030,000 sq. ft. diagnostic/treatment inpatient cancer and critical care tower
- Upgrades to the MEP systems and renovations to four existing healthcare facilities
- The largest healthcare project in Ohio history



### NATIONWIDE & OHIO FARM BUREAU 4-H CENTER

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 45,000 sq. ft., five-story education/training and office center for the Ohio 4-H
- Green features include the following:
  - A reflective roof to reduce air conditioning loads
  - Day lighting to reduce the use of artificial power
  - Use of recycled materials in the building's concrete and steel
  - An adopted occupant recycling program



### WILLIAM OXLEY THOMPSON LIBRARY

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 340,000 sq. ft. addition and renovation to historic campus facility
- Addition of new atrium created an open study/gathering area



### THE OHIO STADIUM

Design Architect: *360 Architecture (formerly HNTB Sports Architecture)*

#### Project Quick Facts:

- Renovation of the historic “Horseshoe” football stadium
- Addition of south stands and new scoreboard
- Lowering the playing field more than 14’
- Project completed around four football seasons
- Recipient of 2002 AGC Build America Award and 2002 AGC Build Ohio Award

#### Project Quick Facts:

- Four-story, 233,740 sq. ft. physical sciences research building
- Facility features over 200 laboratory modules, conference space, a stunning atrium, and adjoining patio space



### SOUTH CAMPUS GATEWAY

Columbus, OH

Architect: Elkus Manfredi

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 938,500 sq. ft. mixed-use development of the OSU / High Street corridor
- The revitalization of the area is anchored by an eight-screen theater and event place, retail stores and restaurants, office space, residential apartments, and a five-story 1,196-car parking garage



### HUNTINGTON PARK

Columbus, OH

Architect: 360 Architecture  
Interior Designer: Moody Nolan

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 200,000 sq. ft. Triple 'A' baseball park – home to the Columbus Clippers, minor league baseball team of the Cleveland Indians
- The open park features a state-of-the-art HD scoreboard, 32 suites, 42 loge boxes, and a club-level patio with two homerun terraces, a picnic area, and lawn seating with a kid's play fountain area



### NATIONWIDE ARENA

Columbus, OH

Architect: 360 Architecture, formerly Heinlein Schrock Stearns

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 685,000 sq. ft., 20,000 seat sports and entertainment arena
- An adjoining 62,500 sq. ft. practice and public ice rink
- The facility also features a four-story, 60,000 sq. ft. office building, a 560-car space parking garage, and retail/restaurant spaces

### LUCAS COUNTY ARENA

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 250,000 sq. ft. , 8,000-8,500 fixed seat multi-venue arena for NHL hockey, arena football, basketball tournaments, and various entertainment concerts/shows
- Registered for USGBC LEED Certification



### GREAT AMERICAN TOWER AT QUEEN CITY SQUARE

Cincinnati, OH

Architect: *Hellmuth, Obata + Hassabaum, Inc. (HOK)*

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 41-story high rise office building in downtown Cincinnati, which will become the tallest building in Cincinnati
- The skyscraper will peak to 660' in height, and be crowned with a unique 440-ton steel tiara inspired by those worn by Princess Diana
- The office building includes 80,000 sq. ft. of office space, a 20,000 sq. ft. retail arcade, a spacious promenade and rotunda, and an 11-story parking garage



### PAUL BROWN STADIUM

Cincinnati, OH

Architect: *NBBJ*

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 66,500-seat, 1,850,000 sq. ft. , 11-story open-air sports facility
- Home to the NFL football team, Cincinnati Bengals, and host facility for professional soccer, concerts, and other large outdoor events
- Accommodations include 7,600-club seats, 112 luxury suites, club lounges, a football training facility, and three practice fields



### ROCK-N-ROLL HALL OF FAME

Cleveland, OH

Architects: *Pei Cobb Freed & Partners*  
*Robert P. Madison International, Inc.*

#### Project Quick Facts:

- 150,000 sq. ft., six-level event facility and museum honoring rock-n-roll music entertainers, producers, disc jockeys, and songwriters
- A six-floor tower was built in the North Coast Harbor with an interconnected cantilevered auditorium structure extending 80' over Lake Erie.
